UNDERSTANDING GLOBALISM

Definition: Globalism refers to the political, economic, and social processes that promote the integration of countries and cultures which can weaken a countries military.

Key Features: Globalism can be supported by Trade Agreements, multinational corporations, international organizations, and cultural exchanges. Pay close attention to Black projects by the government and the activities of The Military Industrial Complex - which main function is to encourage trade and war for the benefit of the sales of arms and military supplies amongst its members.

Navigating the complexities of globalism requires a proactive approach centered around community, education, and political engagement. By focusing on local empowerment and fostering resilience, individuals and communities can thrive amidst the challenges posed by a globalized world. A local government is more attuned to the local needs and is more accountable to its citizens. Localized government encourages the development of local recourses and those sales to directly benefit the hands that labored for them.

Topic One

Participate in Local Governance: To combat globalism it is important to engage politically both locally and nationally. Find a Good Job or Start an Online Business Key Concepts: Securing stable employment or creating opportunities that align with survival skills and community-based needs help a local district and a nation keep job opportunities and revenues at home.

Get Involved in Civic Engagement

Voting: Exercise your right to vote, focusing on candidates who prioritize national interests and local control over globalist policies.

Advocacy Groups: Join or support organizations that align with your views on national sovereignty and localism.

Practical Tips: Foster friendships through regular gatherings, participate in local clubs or groups, and use social media platforms to connect with others who share similar political and national survival interests.

MANDATES AND MILITARY CONTROL OF CITIZENS

Topic Four

Watch for issues that can turn into martial law and shutdowns and advocate against them becoming disproportionate.

One example would be the prolonged and non-voluntary Covid -19 mandates. While national health issues must be managed, non-voluntary mandates present an opportunity for the control of the population beyond the immediate threat. National responsibility and restrictions must be respected during a crisis with the goal of restoring personal freedoms as soon as possible. Any prolonged containment and control of the population is fertile ground for martial law and/or globalism to take root.

Strengthen Community Bonds by Building Networks: Create or join community groups and churches that share interests in local culture, business, and national identity.

Topic Six

Key Concepts: Free Enterprise relies on citizens investing in the education and skills to maintain job market flexibility. Remain open to new ideas and methods for job survival and prosperity that develops local industry while it balances the globally driven economy that would seek to monopolize local assets.

Lifelong Learning: Encourage continuous education and skills development to adapt to changing job markets influenced threatened by global controls.

Vocational Training: Support local initiatives that provide vocational training to prepare residents for high-demand jobs.

PEACE & SPIRITUAL LIVING

Topic Seven

Peace could be very elusive during a worldwide threat because of the stress any individual threat would create in one's life. Let alone if these threats appear in clusters or simultaneously, as often is the case. Dealing with stress is very important during times of personal relationship problems, financial, health, and survival issues. Successful stress management and remaining clear headed could make the difference in your survival.

More than stress management, maintaining your peace during a disaster could prove to be more valuable than the gold you stored to barter with. Having peace can help your family, friends, and all of those around you that are in a critical situation to survive in an abundant way.

Peace is directly associated with spirituality. If you have not considered spirituality, now would be the time to develop it while we are in a relatively peaceful time. Seeking a Higher Power for peace makes since when so many things will be out of your control during a worldwide threat.

Prophecies are comforting and stress reducing because they come from a loving Higher Power that is communicating with his people what to expect. Prophecies for the Christian tell the nature of the times in which Jesus was, is and will be.
