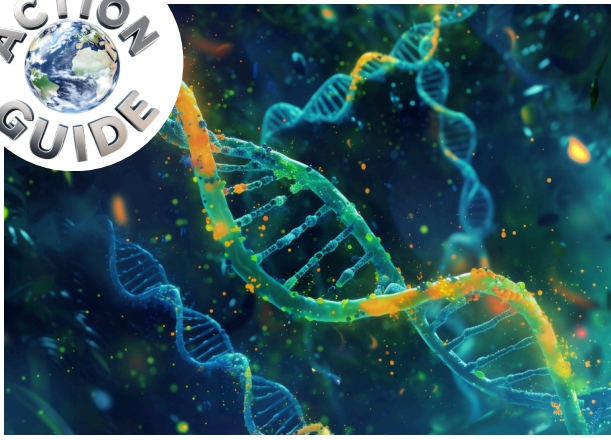

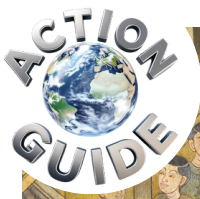
INTRODUCTION

WHAT IS PROPHECY?

Topic Two

Prophecy can be categorized by its purpose, content, and the context of its delivery, encompassing types like predictive, instructive, revelatory, comforting, and warning prophecies, as well as those related to specific individuals or events.

Types of Prophecy

- **Foretelling** - Predicting future events (e.g., the coming of the Messiah).
- **Forthtelling** - Speaking God's truth into the current situation (e.g., calling people to repentance).
- **Modern Views** - Interpretations vary widely, with some believing in the continuation of prophetic gifts today, while others view biblical prophecy as complete.

BREAKDOWN OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF PROPHECY

Topic Three

Based on Purpose/Content:

- **Predictive Prophecy:** Foretelling future events, often with a focus on specific individuals or nations.
- **Instructive/Peremptory Prophecy:** Providing guidance, direction, or moral instruction.
- **Rebuking Prophecy:** Calling out wrongdoing or sin.
- **Comforting Prophecy:** Offering solace, hope, or reassurance.
- **Warning Prophecy:** Alerting people to impending danger or consequences.
- **Sentencing Prophecy:** Pronouncing judgment or punishment.
- **Apocalyptic Prophecy:** Dealing with the end times or cataclysmic events.
- **Revealing Prophecy:** Unveiling hidden truths or knowledge.
- **Announcing Prophecy:** Proclaiming a significant event or message.



BREAKDOWN OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF PROPHECY

Topic Three

Based on Source

- **Prophecy about Ancient Israel:** Focusing on the history, destiny, and role of the Israelites.
- **Prophecy about Jesus:** Foretelling the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.
- **Prophecy of Post-Biblical Events:** Addressing events that occur after the time of the Bible.
- **Prophecy of End-time Events:** Concerning the final days or the end of the world.
- **Prophecy of Personal Revelation:** Direct divine communication to an individual.
- **Prophecy of Guidance:** Providing direction or counsel.
- **Prophecy of Education:** Conveying knowledge or wisdom.
- **Prophecy of Rebuke:** Calling out wrongdoing.
- **Prophecy of Fulfilled Events:** Prophecies that have come true.

Topic Three

Based on Source (cont.)

- **Prophecy of Conditional Events:** Prophecies that depend on human choices or actions.
- **Prophecy of Unrevealed Information:** Prophecies that disclose unknown facts or secrets.
- **Prophecy of the Major Prophets:** Isaiah, Jeremiah, Lamentations, Ezekiel, and Daniel.
- **Prophecy of the Minor Prophets:** Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah, and Malachi.

THE APOSTATE CHURCH

Topic Four

Definition - The term "apostate church" refers to a church or religious community that has abandoned or turned away from foundational truths of the faith, often embracing heretical beliefs or practices.

Characteristics

- **Deviation from Scripture** - Teaching contrary to biblical doctrine.
- **Moral Decline**- Acceptance of practices that contradict traditional Christian ethics.
- **Lack of Spiritual Vitality**- A focus on rituals or social issues rather than a genuine relationship with God.
- **Biblical Warnings**- Scriptures such as 2 Timothy 4:3-4 and Jude 1:17-19 warn of false teachers and the falling away from the faith.
- **Contemporary Context**- Discussions around the apostate church often arise in debates about theological liberalism, cultural accommodation, and the preservation of core Christian beliefs.

END TIMES

Topic Five

Definition - The term "end times" refers to the prophetic period described in the Bible that leads to the final events of human history, including the return of Christ, the final judgment, and the establishment of God's eternal kingdom.

Key Biblical Passages

- **Book of Revelation** - Provides a vivid account of the events leading to the end of the world, including the rise of the Antichrist, the Great Tribulation, and the final battle between good and evil.
- **Matthew 24** - Jesus' teachings on the signs of the end times, including wars, natural disasters, and the spread of false prophets.
- **Thessalonians 4:16-17** - Describes the return of Christ and the resurrection of believers.
- **Signs of the End Times** - Many interpretations exist regarding the signs, including:

PEACE & SPIRITUAL LIVING

Topic Seven

Peace could be very elusive during a worldwide threat because of the stress any individual threat would create in one's life. Let alone if these threats appear in clusters or simultaneously, as often is the case. Dealing with stress is very important during times of personal relationship problems, financial, health, and survival issues. Successful stress management and remaining clear headed could make the difference in your survival.

More than stress management, maintaining your peace during a disaster could prove to be more valuable than the gold you stored to barter with. Having peace can help your family, friends, and all of those around you that are in a critical situation to survive in an abundant way.

Believing Jews look to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob to bring them peace. Prophecies of the Messiah help the Jews focus on God as their victor and keeper. For Jews, their bible predicts the coming of the Messiah who will protect them and establish his forever kingdom.

Those who know the Jesus of the Christian Bible will deal with stress completely differently than those who do not. There are several reasons for that. First, the bible is full of prophecies foretelling the birth and mission of Jesus to make peace between God and mankind in addition to his return to set up a kingdom of His peace. Jesus came and fulfilled the prophecies of his birth, death, and resurrection. Christians have a great deal of evidence that he will keep his promise to return and ultimately establish worldwide peace. The well-known Christmas prophecy hundreds of years before his birth in Isaiah 9:6 identified Jesus as the Prince of Peace. He offers that peace to you today if you but ask (John 14:27).

Prophecies are comforting and stress reducing because they come from a loving Higher Power that is communicating with his people what to expect. Prophecies for the Christian tell the nature of the times in which Jesus was, is and will be.
